A. Anyone over 34 can now get their vaccination



People aged 34 and over are eligible for their vaccination.

Anyone aged 34 and over, those clinically extremely vulnerable, those with an underlying health condition, and unpaid carers are all currently eligible.

To book your vaccination, visit www.nhs.uk/covid-vaccination, call 119, or wait to be contacted by your GP led local vaccination service.

Over 1.8 million vaccinations have been given across Sussex as the roll out continues, with thousands of first and second dose appointments taking place this week.

B. Booking via the National Booking System



The National Booking System both online at nhs.uk/covidvaccine or over the phone by calling 119 only shows services with available appointments. If a vaccination centre currently does not have any available appointments, it will not show up in the list when you log into the system. We encourage eligible people who have been invited to receive their vaccination to keep checking the National Booking System for appointments.

C. Dates for upcoming community clinics



The community team reaching out to those who are eligible and yet to have their vaccine hits the road again this week.

- Saturday 22 May, 10:30 14:30
 St Peter's Church, York Pl, Brighton BN1 4GU
- Sunday 23 May, 10:30 14:30
 Brunswick Square, Hove, BN3

Pre-booked appointments are available for anyone eligible. Limited drop-in appointments are also available.

Getting the vaccine in the community is easy; just bring one form of ID (photo ID not required) and NHS number, if known.

How to book: Call 0300 303 8060 (drop-in is also available)

Who can book: People who are eligible for the vaccine can book now, which includes:

- People over the age of 34 or who will turn 34 before 1st July 2021
- Those who have serious long-term health issues
- Unpaid Carers
- People on the Learning Disability Register

D. Quiet Session, Chichester (for those aged 40 and over ONLY)

There is still time to book for the quiet vaccine session in Chichester, which is being offered to people living in Sussex who are currently eligible for the vaccine and over the age of 40 who may need more time for their appointment, or who have extra access needs where a quieter and calmer environment would help support them to receive their vaccination.

Getting to the Children and Family Centre (Chichester)

Free Transport available to people booked onto the Quiet Vaccination Session.

If you need support with transport to get to the Children and Family Centre (Chichester) for your appointment during the Quiet Session, you can call the travel team on 01444 275 008.

A travel coordinator will ask you a few questions and will help arrange for you to have a safe COVID-secure journey to the Children and Family Centre (Chichester) for all Sussex residents.

If you're able to travel to the Children and Family Centre (Chichester) yourself: The Children and Family Centre (Chichester) is accessible by public transport and there is free parking available on site.

E. Changes to second dose appointments

NHS England has confirmed that appointments for a second vaccine will be brought forward from 12 to 8 weeks for the remaining people in the <u>top nine priority groups</u> who have yet to receive their second dose.

This includes those aged 50 and over, those clinically vulnerable and unpaid carers.

If people have an appointment in the next 10 days this will continue as planned.

If appointments have been booked through the national booking system - online or via 119 - the central team will be contacting people in these groups who have an appointment after this time to bring forward their appointment for the second dose.

If people had their first appointment at a GP led local vaccination service, you will be contacted as soon as your local service is able to offer you the second appointment. You do not need to contact the NHS - please wait to be contacted if you think you are in this group.

People should continue to attend their second dose appointments as planned unless the NHS contacts you.

In general, appointments for second doses are booked at the same time as first doses.

F. Need confirmation of your COVID vaccinations?



The NHS App is now available to use as a vaccine passport (as from Monday 17th May 2021).

A paper version will also be available by calling 119.

Please do not telephone your GP Practice to ask about the vaccine passport as they are unable to provide vaccine passports and it's essential we leave phone lines free for people who need medical assistance.

The NHS App is separate to the NHS COVID-19 App, which is used for contact tracing.

You can already use the NHS App to book appointments, repeat prescriptions and see your full medical records.

Your vaccine passport will only show when you have had both doses.

If you don't have the NHS App, <u>download the NHS App</u> now. It will record when you have had both doses of the vaccine and automatically create a vaccine passport which will be available from Monday 17 May 2021.

If you are planning to travel, please register to use the NHS App at least two weeks before travelling.

The paper letter should be requested at least five days after a second vaccine and can take up to five days to arrive so make sure to leave plenty of time if you need it to travel.

G. Brighton to be part of world-first COVID-19 vaccine booster study



Thousands of volunteers will receive a booster COVID-19 vaccine in a new clinical trial Health Secretary Matt Hancock announced yesterday.

The Cov-Boost study, led by University Hospital Southampton NHS Foundation Trust and backed by £19.3 million of government funding through the Vaccines Taskforce, will trial seven vaccines

and will be the first in the world to provide vital data on the impact of a third dose on patients' immune responses.

One of the 16 bases for the trials will be Brighton, at University Hospitals Sussex NHS Foundation Trust.

It will give scientists from around the globe and the experts behind the UK's COVID-19 vaccination programme a better idea of the impact of a booster dose of each vaccine in protecting individuals from the virus.

Vaccines being trialled include Oxford/AstraZeneca, Pfizer/BioNTech, Moderna, Novavax, Valneva, Janssen and Curevac, as well as a control group. The trial has received ethics approval by the NHS Research Ethics Committee, as well as approval from the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency.

The study will open for applications from volunteers shortly via the <u>study's website</u> and will be recruiting participants through the <u>NHS COVID-19 Vaccine Research Registry</u>.

Participants will be adults aged 30 years or older as these will have been those immunised early on in the vaccination programme - for example, adults aged 75 and over or health and care workers.

I. Progress to date



More than 900,000 people have now received first doses across Sussex

Latest data published today shows that more than 950,000 people have now received their first vaccination.

This includes more than 90% of those aged 70 and over who have now had second dose, and more than 50% of those aged 60 and over who have had both.

This week people aged 34 and over became eligible and are encouraged to use the national

booking system to arrange an appointment.

Anyone in this age group is encouraged to book their appointment through the national booking system online at nhs.uk or by calling 119.
